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## 2024-2025 **HEAD OF SCHOOL** James Detora **ABOUT THE SCHOOL** Founded in 1927, Avon Old Farms School is an independent secondary school for boys. The 399 students include 288 boarders and 111 day students, representing 21 states and 9 foreign countries. Financial aid totaling \$6.1 million has been awarded to 40 percent of the student body. The average class size is 11. Of the Class of 2024, 100 percent of our graduates will attend a four-year college or university. Avon Old Farms School is accredited by NEASC and the State of Connecticut and holds memberships in NEACAC, NACAC, ACCIS, The College Board, AIS, and NAIS. The campus includes 863 acres of land in Avon, a country suburb 12 miles west of Hartford. FACULTY There are 68 full-time and 3 part-time teaching faculty members, 47 of whom live on campus. In addition to teaching, most faculty have dormitory, dining hall, and other extracurricular commitments. ACADEMIC **CURRICULUM** The academic year is divided into semesters with classes meeting three times per week for 55-minute periods. There is an 8-day, project-based intersession program between the first and second semesters during which students focus on a particular area of study that is not necessarily part of the standard curriculum. Three-hour examinations are administered at the end of the second semester. Honors courses are offered in most disciplines. We offer the following AP courses: Calculus (AB and BC), Statistics, Physics C: Mechanics, Biology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Computer Science A, Literature and Composition, United States Government and Politics, World History, United States History, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Psychology, Spanish Language and Culture, African American Studies and Studio Art. For those students who have completed BC Calculus, we offer Multivariable Calculus and Differential Equations. For those who have completed AP Computer Science A, we offer Data Structures. We also have a summer online program that offers 8-week courses for credit or preview. DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS To receive an Avon Old Farms School diploma, a student must have the following course distribution as a minimum: 4 years - English 3 years - Mathematics (includes Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra 2/Trigonometry) 2 years - World Language 3 years - Laboratory Science (includes Biology) 3 years - History (includes United States History) 1 credit - Art or Music CLASS RANK As a matter of school policy, Avon Old Farms School does not rank its students nor does it calculate a cumulative GPA. Avon Old Farms grades on a letter scale, A to F, with pluses and minuses. D- is the lowest passing grade. Grades GRADING for Advanced Placement and Honors courses are "weighted" according to the following rubric:
